All riders must sign Waiver of Liability forms and must provide proof of insurance before being allowed to ride.

All novice riders must submit certification forms.

All people who plan to be on horseback must sign waiver of Liability forms and must wear protective headgear. All race riders must wear protective vests.

All horses must be declared with Pippy McCormick at the paddock one hour prior to their post time listed on this overnight, or they will be scratched.

The use of raised toes (toe grabs) is prohibited. Horses will be scratched or disqualified.

Please check the information on this overnight. Any changes or corrections can be made prior to scratch time to make the program.

Entries must be paid before saddle cloths will be issued.

As required by the Virginia Department of Agriculture: "All horses must be accompanied by a report of an official negative test for equine infectious anemia (Coggins Test) conducted within the last 12 months. The Certificate must accompany all horses in order to gain access to the grounds. This requirement will be strictly enforced. A health certificate must accompany horses shipping from outside Virginia.

Race day declarations and scratches can be made with Pippy McCormick (540) 454-2854.

Due to the extreme amount of rainfall this spring, a partial river of water has developed on the backside of the Blue Ridge point-to-point course.

To the best efforts of organizers, there will be a deviated course to avoid the flowing water and deep mud. We encourage all riders to come early and walk the courses to ensure knowing where to ride and familiarize yourself with the flags. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.
