Scratches by 11:00 am, the Wednesday before the races with the Central Entry Office (540) 439-3820.

All riders must sign Waiver of Liability forms and must provide proof of insurance before being allowed to ride.

All people who plan to be on horseback must sign Waiver of Liability forms and must wear protective headgear. All race riders must wear protective vests.

All horses must be checked in with Pippy McCormick at the paddock one hour prior to their post time listed on this overnight, or they will be scratched.

The use of raised toes (toe grabs) is prohibited. Horses will be scratched or disqualified.

Please check the information on this overnight. Any changes or corrections can be made prior to scratch time to make the program.

Entries must be paid before saddle cloths will be issued.

As required by the Virginia Department of Agriculture: "All horses must be accompanied by a report of an official negative test for equine infectious anemia (Coggins Test) conducted within the last 12 months. The Certificate must accompany all horses in order to gain access to the grounds. This requirement will be strictly enforced. A health certificate must accompany horses shipping from outside Virginia.

**\* REMINDER - MASKS MUST BE WORN BY EVERYONE ON THE GROUNDS EXCEPT RIDERS WHEN ON COURSE. The steeplechase community's cooperation is what's allowed these meets to happen. Please don't compromise future meets.**

**\* No one should have their photo taken - not even selfies or social media shots, without their masks on.**

**\* The course will be set up by Wednesday afternoon of race week - local riders and horsemen are encouraged to walk the course before race day.**

**THERE WILL BE NO OFFICIAL 'GROUP' COURSE WALKS ON RACE DAY.**

**Novice riders and those who have not ridden at Ben Venue extensively are urged to make time late in the week, or early in the day, to walk the course/s with more experienced riders.**

**\* There will not be a printed program -- Print your own copy of the latest, corrected overnight before you come, or ODH will have some photocopied overnights for sponsors and horsemen as they enter the grounds.**

**Specific COVID-19 instructions for horsemen**  
-----

**1. DIRECTIONS:** Horsemen coming from the north and east should navigate to Warrenton. Then take Route 211 west 16 miles to Ben Venue Road/Virginia Route 729 on the right. (There will be signs.)

The course entrance is a quarter mile on the right.

**\* Note - there are no services - fuel, food, etc.(none suitable for a horse trailer) after Warrenton (about 20 minutes from the course.)**

There are no food sales on the grounds and no hospitality tent, so please plan accordingly and bring your own food and drink for a long day.

**\* Horsemen are reminded do not follow GPS directions as they often bring you in from a direction that a big trailer cannot make the turns or down a narrow, rough gravel road impossible for a trailer to navigate.**

**2. TIMING:** To ensure smooth entry into the course, trainers with horses in the first are asked to arrive two hours before post time -- around 10 a.m. for a 12 p.m. post time for the first race. Those with horses in later races may arrive later in the day, no less than two hours before their post time.

**3. ENTRANCE:** There will be ONE entrance for all vehicles entering the Ben Venue course.

\* Once inside the gate, horsemen (trailers and cars) will be directed into an "outside" lane for COVID check-in. There, two volunteers will swipe temperatures of all vehicle occupants and a third will collect waiver forms. This is to keep traffic moving quickly.

4. WAIVERS: Everyone entering the grounds must present a printed, filled in COVID-19 waiver form and a health questionnaire (attached, and available at [centralentryoffice.com](http://centralentryoffice.com).) Print it out and bring it with you please so there are no hold-ups at the gate choke-point.

\* Everyone will be given a wristband when fully checked in -- one color for sponsor tailgate parking, another color for horsemen. No horsemen without a sponsor's wristband will be allowed into the hillside sponsor area; no sponsors without a horsemen's wristband will be allowed into the paddock and horsemen's area.

\* Extra supporters from each barn not working as essential personnel on race day are encouraged to purchase a sponsor's tailgate space -- these socially distanced parking spots allow viewing of the entire course for a car with up to 6 occupants. (You may certainly watch the races from the trailer parking area, but there is little view of the course.)

5. HORSEMEN'S LIAISONS: As horsemen proceed to the van parking area, look for your two horsemen's liaisons stationed in the van area to orchestrate the day. Rob Banner and Brandon Barry will coordinate parking to keep related parties together, to direct 'late-day' runners to quieter, further out spaces so they can hand-walk and hand-graze, and coordinate with direct communication to the paddock and stewards' tower.

\* There is not a barn (permanent or temporary) at Ben Venue -- Please come prepared to run 'off the van.' There will be a water truck with horse water for drinking and washing, and there will be iced water for baths at the finish line and in the paddock, but bring everything you need for the day otherwise.

\* There are ODH members with farms 10 minutes from the racecourse for those wishing to ship in the night before (stalls, paddocks, B and B rooms), or arriving early Saturday but wanting a stall (or paddock) for a few hours before going to the course. (This applies to horses, officials or riders.) Contact Betsy Parker - 540-229-2048.

6. NO JOCKEYS TENT: There will not be a jockeys tent. Riders are asked to change in the van area, or, using due modesty, in the trainer-rider parking area (beside the paddock.)

\* There will be a jockeys' trailer parked by the check-in trailer (by the paddock) to use as a staging area -- place tack bags and silks here for quick swaps between races if you're riding back-to-back.

\* There will be seats, iced water, sports drinks and a small selection of snacks for riders in this staging area.

7. SHUTTLE: There will be a gator and runners between the paddock, van parking and racecourse to shuttle people and tack.

8. CHECK-IN: Report runners 'on the grounds' and rider assignments with race day secretary Pippy McCormick at a horse trailer by the paddock. This is where you will pick up your saddle cloths and report late scratches, changes and rider assignments. Contact Pippy with any issues - 540-454-2854.

9. WEIGH-OUT, WEIGH-IN: The clerk of the scales will be located by the check-in trailer. All riders weigh OUT here. All but the winner will weigh IN here. (The winner will weigh in at the winners' circle.)

10. PADDOCK TIME: All horses will tack in the van area. A half-hour before each post time, the horsemen's liaisons will give a count-down to paddock time, and then coordinate a procession to the paddock. (Late tack changes/additions can be handled in the paddock, but please, mostly in the van area.)

11. SOUNDNESS CHECK: Each horse will jog for the vet at the entrance to the paddock.

12. RIDERS UP: Riders and trainers (no owners please) can meet in the paddock for final instructions (masks up), leg up and out onto the course. The expectation is to minimize time in the paddock, so please plan for 'one circuit' and out.

\* There will be two mounted outriders to lead the post parade and assist on course. Trainers may bring their stable ponies; please follow all safety protocol above, and anyone mounted must sign a rider waiver (with Pippy McCormick.)

13. VIEWING: Those with a horsemen's wristband may follow the horses out of the paddock to the entrance to the course just past the wire. You may view from the outer rail here -- keep social distance please and keep your masks on.

\* Trainers and essential personnel with horses in that race will be allowed onto the course to a secure area on the infield. Please do not abuse this privilege as this is a small viewing area, and please keep social distance.

14. AFTER EACH RACE: Riders pull up after the wire. Only the winner will return to the winners' circle under the wire (or top finishers if it is a close finish.) The winner will stand up in the winners' circle for a mounted photo, unsaddle and weigh in for \*very brief\* trophy presentation and win photos. Please ensure all masks are up (including the rider, groom, etc.) in the win shots.

\* All other finishers pull up and exit the course where they entered. Return to the paddock to unsaddle and weigh in.

\* This places riders and their tack near the scales and the paddock staging area. Please have your tack and equipment organized for your next mount to minimize delays between races.

\* The shuttle will be ready to ferry tack back to the van parking as each race concludes.
