ATTENTION: FAILURE TO READ AND OBEY THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS MAY RESULT IN YOUR ENTRIES NOT BEING ACCEPTED OR YOUR HORSES BEING SCRATCHES.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 1. ATTENTION: Horseman are liable for all entry fees that are made for each point to point or hunter pace event. A scratch does not void an entry fee.
- 2. All horses, owners, trainers and riders must be acceptable to the Race Committee.
- 3. The Race Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.
- 4. The Race Committee may vary the conditions or courses in any way which may seem in the best interests of the race meets.
- 5. The Race Committee reserves the right to split, combine or cancel any race.
- 6. The Race Committee and the owners of the properties on which the races are held assume no responsibility for injury or loss incurred by either participants or spectators, and entries are accepted only under the condition that the participants release them from any and all liabilities.
- 7. The Stewards shall exercise immediate supervision, control and regulation of racing at each point to point. Race Day Stewards have the authority to assess fines on trainers and riders for specific infractions of rules. By entering a horse in a VPPF Sanctioned race, trainers and riders agree to abide by those rules governing fines.
- 8. An official veterinarian may recommend to the Stewards that an entry be scratched due to unsoundness
- 9. There must be a minimum of 10 runners before the Stewards will consider splitting races unless an unforeseen circumstance arises.
- Races will be split at the Stewards discretion when there are more than the number of starters allowed in each point-topoints conditions.
- Violations of any of the general conditions may result in denial of the right to participate in races on the Virginia Point-to-Point Circuit.
- 12. Pre-race veterinary examinations will be conducted.
- 13. An official veterinarian may recommend to the Stewards that an entry be scratched due to unsoundness.
- 14. NO protrusions below the ground surface of the shoe. Outer rims are permitted, provided any toe grab or wear plate is level with the outer rim. Block heels, not to exceed 1/4 inch, are permitted behind provided they are labeled as Block Heels by the manufacturer and any toe grab or wear plate is level with the majority of the ground surface of the shoe.
- 15. Horses must be entered and run under registered names.

- 16. All allowances must be claimed at the time of entry. Allowances for maidens apply to the type races (timber, hurdle, flat) in which they are entered. Correct weights are the responsibility of the person making the entry.
- 17. In all series races, weight penalties apply only to the current season.
- Current coggins tests are required and must be available on race day; likewise a health certificate must accompany horses shipping from outside of Virginia.
- 19. Horses must be checked in at the scratch board near the paddock with the Race Day Secretary no later than one hour prior to the post time listed on the overnight sheet of the first race in which they are entered. This will be strictly enforced.
- 20. Scratch time is 11:00 a.m. the Wednesday prior to the races at the **Central Entry office (484) 897-0096**
- 21. Trainers of horses late to the paddock may be fined \$100 the first time, \$200 the second time, and for the third offense the trainer may be suspended. Riders late to the paddock may be fined \$50 the first time, \$100 the second time and for the third offense the rider may be suspended.
- 22. The minimum weight carried in races over hurdles is 130 lbs.; over timber, 140 lbs. and 130 lbs. for races on the flat.
- 23. Mares allowed 7 lbs. in races not restricted to fillies or mares.
- 24. In all open races, novice riders will be allowed 10 lbs. until 15th win. **Trainers are responsible for correct weights.**
- 25. Novice Riders over fences will be allowed 10 lbs. in nonseries races over fences (including the novice timber series). A novice is a rider who has not won ten **sanctioned** races over fences prior to January 1 of the current year **under any** racing jurisdiction.
- Minimum age for all riders will be sixteen. This does not apply to pair, junior races and Restricted Young Adult Flat Races.
- 27. A junior is a rider who has not reached his or her sixteenth birthday as of January 1 of the current year.
- 28. All riders must read and sign waiver of liability forms, and they must be filed at the scratch board near the paddock before being allowed to participate in any race on the Virginia Point-to-Point Circuit. In case of minors the signing of indemnification agreements will be required by parents only.
- 29. Outriders and all other persons on horses/ponies on the grounds are required to wear protective head gear and to read and sign waiver of liability forms, and these forms must be on file.Races will be split at the Stewards discretion when there are more than the number of starters allowed in each point-to-points conditions.

30. ALL NOVICE RIDERS WILL BE REQUIRED TO HAVE A REPRESENTATIVE SIGN AN AFFIDAVIT

STATING THAT THE NOVICE RIDER IS COMPETENT TO COMPETE AT THIS LEVEL. REPRESENTATIVE IS EITHER TRAINER Α Α OR Α **KNOWLEDGABLE** RACING **OFFICIAL** (ACCEPTABLE TO THE COMMITTEE) FAMILIAR WITH THE ASPECTS OF RACE RIDING AND HAS WITNESSED OR WORKED WITH THE NOVICE RIDER. RIDERS WHO DO NOT HAVE A CURRENT ASSOCIATION WORKING WITH A TRAINER SHOULD CONTACT DON YOVANOVICH, (540) 270-0115, FOR ACCREDITATION PROCEDURES. ****NOVICE RIDER CERTIFICATION FORMS CAN BE DOWNLOADED FROM THE CENTRAL ENTRY** OFFICE WEBSITE.

- Every rider in all races must check out and in with the Clerk of Scales. This also applies in races where weight is listed as "catch weights".
- 32. All races will be ridden in proper race or hunting attire and protective head gear. All riders must wear protective vests. Overgirths are required in all races. This MAY not pply to exhibition races.
- 33. Riders are responsible for their own lead weights.
- 34. Any rider who falls or is thrown will not be allowed to ride again during the day until he or she is examined and cleared by the official physician and the stewards are so advised by the official physician.
- 35. Outriders and all other persons on horses/ponies on the grounds are required to wear protective head gear and to read and sign waiver of liability forms, and these forms must be on file.
- 36. Lead ponies or horses will be allowed only to take horses to the start and then must clear the race course and remain stationary until the completion of the race. In all races horses or ponies may be led to the start but released when under starter's orders. Exceptions will be at the discretion of the starter.
- 37. THE VPPF AS THE NSA, WILL ABIDE BY THE HISA CROP RULE, THAT RIDERS WILL BE LIMITED TO STRIKE A HORSE ONLY SIX (6) TIMES DURING A RACE. VIOLATIONS MAY RESULT IN A FINE OR SUSPENSION. JOCKEYS MUST USE THE PROCUSH "NATIONAL HUNT" MODEL APPROVED BY THE STEWARDS, FOR FURTHER INFORMATION ON THE VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES GO TO HISA.
- Point-to-Points are not sanctioned by the NSA, therefore results will have no effect on a horse's eligibility in sanctioned races.
- 39. The NSA Rule Book is used where applicable.

CONDITIONS GOVERNING ENTRIES POINT TO POINTS AND PAIR EVENTS

- 1. Attention: Horsemen are liable for all entry fees that are made for each point to point or pair event. A scratch does not void an entry fee.
- 2. Number cloths will not be issued until entry fees are paid.
- 3. All entry fees are the responsibility of the person making the entry.
- 4. Entry fees should be paid by check (not cash) to the Race Clerk when reporting horses in on race day.
- 5. Entries will not be allowed to start until past year's entry fees have been paid.
- 6. Failure to pay entry fees in a prompt manner will result in denial of entry privileges.
- 7. The Racing Secretary reserves the right to extend the closing of entries to facilitate the filling of races. This may apply to a race or races that do not fill at the time of closing.
- The order of races on race day may be different from the order in the condition book. It is the participant's responsibility to be informed by the overnight sheet or by telephone.
- 9. All entries by telephone to CENTRAL ENTRY OFFICE at (484) 897-0096 or by email alissa@centralentryoffice.com between 8:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. on the Monday preceding the races. Scratches or changes must be made by 11:00 a.m. the Wednesday preceding the races by telephone or email.

POST ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ALLOWED UNLESS AN EXCEPTION IS INCLUDED ON THE OVERNIGHT TO FACILITATE FILLING RACES.

POINTS IN ALL SERIES WILL BE AWARDED TO THE FIRST FOUR FINISHERS: 5-3-2-1. IN THE CASE OF A WALKOVER HALF POINTS WILL BE AWARDED.

POINTS AWARDED TO TRAINERS WILL BE ONE POINT FOR WINS OVER JUMPS AND 1/2 POINT FOR WINS ON THE FLAT.

(In order to be eligible for year-end awards horses and or riders must make at least two starts and must WIN AT LEAST ONE RACE.)



VIRGINIA POINT TO POINT CHAMPIONSHIP & SERIES CONDITIONS SEVEN CORNERS AMATUER/NOVICE RIDER TIMBER SERIES

Perpetual Trophy donated by Times Community Papers

For five-year-olds and up, which have not won a timber race under rules since 1/1/2023 other than maiden and are ridden by amateur or novice riders, who hunt with any recognized or organized foxhunting or beagle packs whose entry is acceptable to the Seven Corners Committee. An Amateur is defined as a rider who has not accepted compensation for riding in races since 2020. A Novice is defined as a rider. who has not won ten sanctioned or point to point races over fences prior to January 1 of the current year under any racing jurisdiction. Riders and horses must have hunted six or more times and for at least half of the hunting day with any recognized foxhunting pack during the current season. Proper certification of the rider is the responsibility of the rider, is to be kept chronicling one's hunting days and signed by the Master(s). Proper certification of the owner is the responsibility of the owner and is to be kept chronicling one's hunting days and signed by the Master(s). The horse and rider do not necessarily have to hunt together. Minimum weight as established by conditions of each race, the minimum carried to be not less than 165 lbs. (excepting maiden allowance of 10 lbs. and mare allowance of 7 lbs.) or such lower weight as may be agreed in the paddock by unanimous consent of all riders, competing for Seven Corners points and approved by the Hunt Race Committee. An additional 3 lbs. is to be assessed for each Seven Corners win during a given season, up to a total of 6 lbs. over the base weight. No rider allowances. In the event that a base weight of less than 165 lbs. is set by the entered owner/riders in a given race, the assessed 3 to 6 lb. handicaps will be added to the reduced base weight. Maidens over timber are allowed 10 lbs.

Series races at Rappahannock, Warrenton, Piedmont, Old Dominion and Blue Ridge.

FOXHUNTER TIMER SERIES

For foxhunting riders (ladies or gentlemen), who have not won ten sanctioned or point to point races over fences since 2020 with the exception of pair, old-fashioned or foxhunters-only races, on five-year-olds and up. A rider/horse combination that has won five races over fences prior to January 1 of the current year is not eligible to compete in this series. Riders and horses must have hunted six or more times and for at least half of the hunting day with any recognized foxhunting pack during the current season. Certification will be required prior to participation in the series and must be filed with the Central Entry Race Secretary or Race Day Secretary prior to issue of number cloths on race day. Masters must certify in writing that both the horse and rider have hunted regularly and fairly during the current season. Proper certification, which is the responsibility of the fox hunter, is to be kept chronicling one's hunting days and signed by the Master(s). Weight 165 lbs. Maidens allowed 10 lbs. An additional 3 lbs. is to be assessed for each win during a given season, up to a total of 6 lbs. over the base weight. Riders must wear foxhunting attire. No rider allowances. This race will be combined with the Amateur/

Novice timber race unless there are three starters. In combined races the foxhunter finishers will accrue points, and eligibility will be affected as if the foxhunter race was a separate event. In combined races the base weight will be 165 lbs.

Series races at Rappahhannock, Warrenton, Piedmont, Old Dominion and Blue Ridge.

ALL NOVICE RIDERS MUST COMPLY WITH GENERAL CONDITION # 30.

THE HUME STABLE LEADING NOVICE RIDER ON THE FLAT THE SHR FRED PLATE

For Riders who have not won **ten sanctioned or point to point** races on the flat prior to January 1 of the current year under any racing jurisdiction (NSA, ARCA or Fegentri or any other recognized racing jurisdiction; excluding junior, pair and old-fashioned races). <u>COURSE WALKS ARE HIGHLX</u> ENCOURAGED.

Series races at Warrenton, Old Dominion, Blue Ridge and Middleburg

LEADING NOVICE RIDER OVER FENCES Sponsored by New Hope Farm LLC.

For riders in non-series races over fences who have not won **ten sanctioned or point to point** races over fences prior to January 1 of the current year under any racing jurisdiction. Points earned in the Amateur/Novice Rider Hurdle Series and the Amateur/Novice Timber Series will be included in this award counted.

PAGELAND AMATEUR/NOVICE HURDLE SERIES Sponsored by Pageland Farm

For four-Year-Olds and up, which have not won under rules since 1/1/2022 other than in maiden, ratings races at 115 or less, claiming races or amateur rider only races and that are ridden by an amateur or novice rider and restricted apprentice rider races. An amateur is defined as a rider who has not accepted compensation for riding in races since 2020. A novice is defined as a rider, who has not won ten sanctioned or point to point races over fences prior to January 1 of the current year under any racing jurisdiction. Weight 155 lbs. Maidens allowed 10 lbs. An additional 3 lbs. is to be assessed for each win by the horse during a given season, up to a total of 6 lbs. over the base weight. No rider allowances will be allowed. Points will be awarded to horse/rider combinations.

Series races at Warrenton, Blue Ridge, Old Dominion and Middleburg.

VIRGINIA GOLD CUP NOVICE TIMBER HORSE OF THE YEAR Sponsored by The Virginia Gold Cup Association

For Five-Year-Olds and Up, which have not won two point to point races or one NSA sanctioned race over timber prior to January 1 of the current year.

Series races at Warrenton, Blue Ridge.

VIRGINIA TIMBER HORSE OF THE YEAR Sponsored by Charles Fenwick, Jr. for the Temple Gwathmey Foundation. To be selected by a panel.

VIRGINIA HURDLE HORSE OF THE YEAR

To be selected by a panel.

RACE MARE OF THE YEAR

Sponsored by Melanie and Loring Heard

Points awarded to mares in races over fences. Half points will be awarded in maiden or novice races,

RIDER OF THE YEAR

Points awarded in races over fences to both gentlemen and lady riders.

LADY RIDER OF THE YEAR

Points awarded to lady riders in races over fences.

LADY RIDER TIMBER SERIES

Points awarded in designated lady rider races over timber. Series races at Rappahannock, Piedmont and Blue Ridge.

LEADING TRAINER

Full points awarded for winning races over fences, half points awarded for races on the flat.

RESTRICTED YOUNG ADULT FLAT

For Five-Year-Olds and Up to be ridden by amateurs, 15 - 20 years old. Any rider younger than 15 must seek approval from the committee before entering. Weight 140 lbs. Maidens allowed 10 lbs.

Series races at Old Dominion, Loudoun and Middleburg.

VHBPA SPRING FLAT SERIES

Purses and Awards sponsored by the VHBPA

The Virginia Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association (VHBPA) is sponsoring a series of flat races for Registered Virginia Bred or Sired horses. A Virginia Bred certificate from the Virginia Thoroughbred Association must be available if requested. The VHBPA is offering a \$2,000 purse to be paid through the first five finishers for each of these races. Purse distribution in all races: 60% to first, 20% to second, 11% to third, 5% to fourth, 4% to fifth. Races will be carded for Virginia Bred or Sired maidens and winners. Point to point winners on the flat are not considered maidens.

Series races at Warrenton, Piedmont, Old Dominion, Blue Ridge and Loudoun.

GOOD HANDS AND HEELS SERIES FOR NOVICE RIDERS

Award donated by Don Yovanovich and sponsored by Len Gold in memory of Robyn D. Yovanovich.

All novice riders both on the flat and over jumps are eligible for this series award. A selection of knowledgeable horsemen will judge riders on their racing abilities and skills. Riders will be permitted to carry a pro-crush stick but not use the stick behind the saddle turned over in his/her hand on the shoulder. Judges will watch for stick use restricted only as an aid to steering, turning, correction of lead changes, keeping position and stretch finish urging on the horse's shoulder. Points will be awarded as a rider exhibits his ability to maintain good racing positions, judging pace and his/her finish placing. Style, seat, control, negotiating beacons and turns, making good racing decisions and whether or not an optimum ride was executed will also be considered in evaluating the rider's performance.

GROOMS AWARD Awarded by friends of Phillip Hughes, son of Michael and Diane Hughes.

This award will recognize a person, who is seldom in the spotlight but whose contributions are essential in the care of the horses and their success on race day. To be selected by a panel.

THE PAGELAND TIMBER HORSE CHALLENGE Sponsored by Bruce Collette Presented at the annual VPPF Awards Party

Points will be awarded 10-6-4-2 to the first four places in open and lady races and half points will be earned in maiden, novice, amateur and novice rider timber and foxhunter races.

IN ORDER TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR YEAR-END AWARDS HORSES AND OR RIDERS MUST MAKE AT LEAST TWO STARTS AND MUST WIN AT LEAST ONE RACE. YEAR-END AWARDS IN A SERIES WILL NOT BE AWARDED IF THERE ARE NOT THREE RACES RUN IN THE SERIES

HUNTER PACE SERIES CONDITIONS

- Championships are awarded in five divisions: Adult Optimum Time, Junior/Junior or Adult/Junior Optimum Time, Fast Time Adults, Optimum Time on the Flat Junior/ Junior or Adult/Junior Optimum time.
- 2. The Junior/Junior or Adult/Junior Optimum Time divisions are open to pairs of juniors or pairs consisting of an adult and a junior.
- 3. Juniors in pair races are those who have not reached their 16th birthday as of January 1 of the current year.
- 4. To accrue points for year-end titles the horse/rider combinations must remain consistent. (The same horse and rider at each meet.)
- 5. To be eligible for points for the year-end awards a pair must be pre-entered. Pre-entered pairs may change divisions on the day of the event.
- 6. For pairs or teams of horses or ponies at catch weights.
- 7. Horses and rider must have fairly hunted for at least six times during the current season with any fox hunting or beagle pack or pony club. This does not apply to the Open Hunter Pace Events.
- 8. Pair members do not have to represent the same hunt.
- 9. Distances of the events range from $2 \frac{1}{2}$ to $3 \frac{1}{2}$ miles.
- 10. All entries in series races must be made to the Central Entry Office (484) 897-0096 or <u>centralentryoffice.com</u>
- 11. In order to be eligible for year-end awards in all divisions, entries must be made by 11:00 am Wednesday. Post entries and cross entries are allowed, but under no circumstances will points be awarded to these entries.
- 12. Declare the division in which you are competing at the time of entry.
- 13. SERIES DIVISIONS ENTRY FEE IS \$100 PER TEAM. OPEN DIVISION SERIES PRE-ENTRY WILL BE \$50 PER HORSE. POST ENTRY FEE WILL BE \$55 PER HORSE.
- 14. Entry fees must be paid to the secretary and release forms signed before a number pinney will be issued.
- 15. Current coggins test is required and must be available on day of event. Likewise a health certificate must accompany horses shipping from outside of Virginia.
- 16. Insurance waivers must be signed before anyone can compete.
- 17. NO SCHOOLING. Course may be walked in advance.
- 18. Pairs running for fast time go first.
- 19. Any fall of horse or rider will not be eligible for points.

HUNTER PACE EVENT OVER FENCES

For pairs of horses/ponies and riders that have fairly hunted during the current season with any foxhound or beagle pack or pony club. Catch weights. There will be three divisions of pairs run in the following order: Adult Fast Time, Junior/Junior or Adult/Junior Optimum Time. Teams must declare division at the time of entry. Entry fee \$100 per team; No Post Entries. Points count toward year-end awards.

HUNTER PACE EVENT ON THE FLAT

For pairs of horses/ponies and riders that have fairly hunted during the current season with any foxhound or beagle pack or pony club. Catch weights. Two divisions of pairs including Adults or Junior/ Junior or Adult/Junior combination. Optimum Time only. Teams must declare division at the time of entry. Entry fee \$100 per team; No Post Entries. Points count toward year-end awards.

OPEN HUNTER PACE EVENT OVER FENCES

Open to all pairs or three or four member teams of horses/ponies and riders. Catch weights. Junior/Junior or Adult/Junior Optimum Time and Adult Optimum Time. May be ridden in ratcatcher or formal hunting attire. Entry fee \$50 per horse; Post entries accepted. All Post entries (entries made after 11:00 am on Wednesday) will be \$55 per horse.

OPEN HUNTER PACE EVENT ON THE FLAT

Open to all pairs or three or four member teams of horses/ponies and riders. Catch weights. Junior/Junior or Adult/Junior Optimum Time and Adult Optimum Time. May be ridden in ratcatcher or formal hunting attire. Entry fee \$50 per horse; Post entries accepted. All Post entries (entries made after 11:00 am on Wednesday) will be \$55 per horse.

Purse \$1,500. \$1,500 to winner. About 2 miles. For Four Year Olds and Up. Four year olds, 150 lbs; older, 155 lbs. Maidens allowed 10 lbs. Winners under NSA rules over hurdles in 2024-25, 10 lbs. extra.

Second Race - MAIDEN HURDLE

Purse \$1,000. \$1,000 to winner. About 2 miles. For Four Year Olds and Up which have never won over hurdles. For Four year olds 150 lbs; older, 155 lbs. Third Race - MAIDEN TIMBER

Purse \$1,000. \$1,000 to winner. About 2 1/2 miles. For Five Year Olds

and Up which have never won over timber. 165 lbs. Fourth Race - LADY RIDER TIMBER

Fourth Race - LADY RIDER HMBER

About 2 1/2 miles. For Five Year Olds and Up to be ridden by lady riders. 150 lbs. Maidens allowed 10 lbs. Winners under NSA rules over timber in 2024-25, 10 lbs. extra

Fifth Race - OPEN TIMBER

Purse \$1,500. \$1,500 to winner. About 3 miles. For Five Year Olds and Up. 165 lbs. Maidens allowed 10 lbs. Winners under NSA rules over timber in 2024-25, 10 lbs. extra.

Sixth Race - AMATEUR AND NOVICE RIDER TIMBER

About 2 1/2 miles. For Five Year Olds and Up. Seven Corners Series Conditions. 165 lbs. Maidens allowed 10 lbs. For each series win 3 lbs. extra up to 6 lbs. over the base weight.

Sixth Race (2nd Division) - FOXHUNTER TIMBER

About 3 miles. For Five Year Olds and Up. Foxhunter Series Conditions. 165 lbs. Maidens allowed 10 lbs. For each series win 3 lbs. extra up to 6 lbs. over the base weight. This race may be combined with the amateur and novice rider timber race.

Seventh Race - OPEN FLAT


